## **WESTERN CANADIAN CROP PRODUCTION SHOW: DAY 3**

SASKATOON, Saskatchewan – Attendance at the show yesterday was strong, with 6360 people, an increase of 9% from 2011 day two attendance.

Day 3 of the Western Canadian Crop Production show includes the first of two clinics, **Spraying Innovations – a Crop Protection Technology Clinic** focusing on nozzles and peripherals. Attendees will learn about proper calibration, critical points of operation, tips on applying economics and agronomics, and equipment adjustments. Key note speaker Tom Wolf, Research Scientist at Agriculture & Agri-Food Canada, will provide an overview of five key issues that are of increasing importance in spraying: Application Accuracy, Uniformity, Water Volume, Boom Height and Spray Quality. Participating manufacturers include: Trimble, John Deere, Raven and Outback. The clinic involves a lunch break with special speaker Garnet Welykholowa from Capstan Ag Systems. The clinic will take place in Hall A with registration at 8:00 a.m.

Two presentations will take place at the Bayer CropScience Information Theatre – at 12:00 p.m. Edgar Hammermeister from Western Ag Labs Ltd. will be presenting “Getting Serious About ROI – The Impact of Balanced Crop Nutrition” and at 2:00 p.m. Mike Plypchuk from the Ministry of Agriculture will be presenting “Grain Storage Costs and Options”. Edgar will discuss optimizing crop nutrition for optimum financial returns. Mike will review how to determine the best grain storage system for you and how to determine your annual costs per bushel of grain storage.
